SCHOOL ATTENDANCE

Attendance at school is compulsory for children and any absences, whole or partial days, must be explained by a parental note, or phone call to the office. Regulations require us to send a letter home whenever a child has been away for 2 days, if we have not received an explanation. A phone call or note will save a lot of confusion. Extended absences of more than 12 days e.g. holidays or visits to separated parents, need to be discussed with the Principal before leaving. If a child is to leave the school grounds during hours, written permission from a parent is required in advance. Late arrivals and early leavers must report to the office on arrival or before leaving school. Children need to be at school on time. The Home School Liaison Officer will be advised of those children who are consistently late to school and further action will be forthcoming.

Home School Liaison Officers are appointed by the Department of Education and Training to enquire into short or long term unexplained absences. (Note: unexplained absences after 7 days remain unexplained). Mrs Chambers monitors all attendance issues, any concerns regarding attendance can be directed to either Mrs White or Mrs Chambers. The new department guidelines are very clear and long term unexplained absences may lead to prosecution if a positive attendance plan is not adhered to.

SAFETY AROUND THE SCHOOL

School Crossing Supervisors' program is an important component of the Safety Around School program. The crossing will be supervised both before and after school. Please speak with your children about using this crossing and ensuring that they wait sensibly and listen carefully to instructions from the crossing supervisor.

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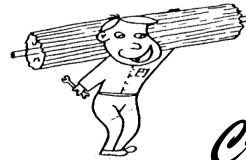
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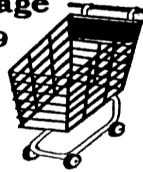
