WATER SAFETY

RULES TO SWIM BY:

- · Learn to swim
- Always swim together—never swim alone
- If you are in difficulty—FLOAT AND WAVE
- REACH to rescue using a stick, rope or clothing
- Never DIVE into shallow or unknown waters
- · Always wear a life jacket when in a boat

AT THE BEACH:

- When at the beach, always swim between the flags
- Never swim too far from the shore or in water too deep for you
- · Always obey the lifesaver on duty
- Don't swim straight after a meal—wait at least half an hour
- . Only use surfboards in the areas marked for board use
- Never swim if the beach is closed or when the sea is rough.

AT THE POOL:

- Never run around the edge of the pool
- · Do not "bomb" others while they are swimming
- Do not "duck" another swimmer ... this could endanger the person
- Swim and play sensibly and safely at all times.


