CLASS MEETINGS

MAJOR AIMS OF WILLIAM GLASSER'S CLASS MEETINGS

1. To increase involvement between the teacher and students and among students themselves. (Involvement is a important way to motivate students to learn.)
2. To develop students' analytical and creative thinking abilities as they tackle open-ended situations in which answers are not dependent on memory and are not categorical (ie Yes or No)
3. To develop in students a "success identity" as they contribute to class meetings and are listened to.
4. To develop students' confidence and skills in expressing their ideas and opinions.
5. To develop students' listening skills as they listen to each other.
6. To develop in students socially responsible attitudes (eg concern for others), and socially responsible behaviours (eg respecting the ideas, opinions and feelings of others).
7. To develop cooperative ways of solving problems which affect individual class members or the class as a whole. (This also helps students feel that they "belong" to the class.)

WEEK 2

Safe Travel to and from School



WALKING

- walk straight to school in the morning
- walk straight home in the afternoon

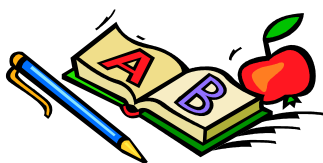

 2. **\$65 Personal Player Registration (12 mths) or \$35 for new players. (to be paid at stadium)**
- All teams must complete an official nomination form and hand it to Peter McDonald or Liz Johnsen.
 - Nominations fees must accompany forms.
 - Only players listed on the nomination form are eligible to play in teams
 - New players must be registered before playing.
 - A skills clinic will be run on Thursday, 2nd February, 2012 for interested players. (Cost TBA)
 - Trial games will be played on Thursday, 2nd February, 2012 for teams already nominated.
 - Competitions will commence on Thursday, 16th February, 2012. Grand finals will be held on Thursday, 28th June, 2012. There will be NO basketball on 12th April
 - A forfeit fee is payable by any team who forfeits without giving notice.
 - Teams are still required to supply one person to do bench duties for their game.
 - All teams are to supply the name of someone who will be placed on a roster and expected to do COURT SUPERVISION at some stage throughout the competition.
 - Teams are asked to supply a referee.

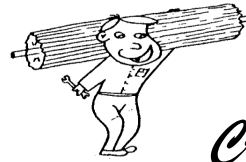
