1. Is it a new program for supporting students with disabilities?

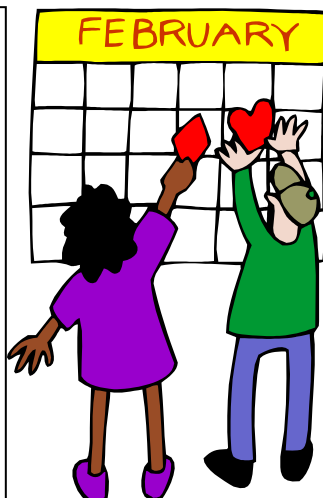

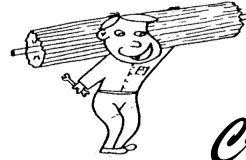

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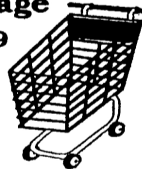
