ALL CHILDREN BEING SAFE

The Australian Institute of Family Studies is evaluating the *All Children Being Safe* program being run at your child's school.

All primary schools in NSW run programs that teach children about strategies and behaviours that can help protect them from harm. At Hillvue Public School staff have been working with other professionals (such as psychologists) to run the *All Children Being Safe* program.

The *All Children Being Safe* program uses stories and activities to help students identify safe people, safe and unsafe feelings and places, and encourages children to talk with trusted people who'll support them.

We'd like to hear from you about things such as

- Your impressions of the program
- How your child felt about the program
- Whether or not you feel your child benefited from the program

There will be group interviews with parents at local schools on Tuesday 12th and Wednesday 13th June. Interviews will last less than an hour and will be conducted during school hours and again in the evening to try to enable as many people as possible to attend.

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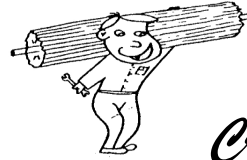
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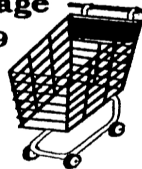
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
