All schools are incorporated in the project activities that will take place through this initiative.

How will the projects in the Every Student, Every School: Learning and Support initiative be funded?

The Australian Government is providing an additional \$47.9 million to NSW over two years under the national partnership agreement: *More*

*Support for Students with Disabilities.* The funding will be used to support projects agreed under the national partnership.

This funding builds on the existing funding for students with disability provided by the NSW Government, \$1.18 billion this financial year.

Non-government education jurisdictions have separate funding agreements directly with the Commonwealth.

## TRAVEL TO AND FROM SCHOOL

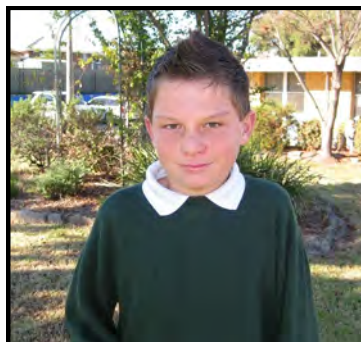
Research has shown that physical activity such as walking and cycling has a positive life-long impact on children, including greater intellectual skills and social skills.
