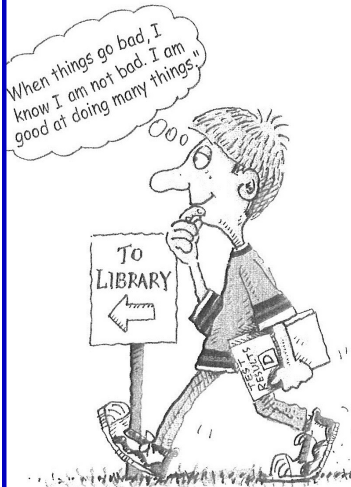

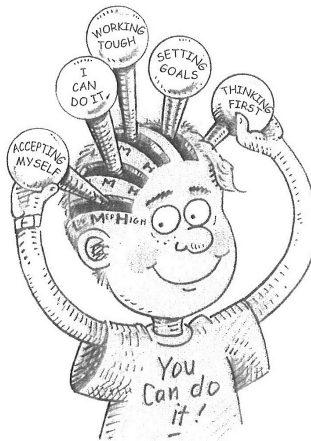

Habits of the Mind to Help My Confidence

Accepting Myself means not thinking badly about myself when I make a mistake

Taking Risks means thinking that it's good to try something new even though I might not be able to do it.

Being independent means thinking that it's important for me to try new activities and to speak up even if classmates think I'm silly or stupid.

I Can Do It! Means thinking that even when my work is hard, I can still do it.

Try using this language at home with your family ...

Safe Travel to and from School



WALKING

- walk straight to school in the morning
- walk straight home in the afternoon
- walk on the footpath
- cross the road carefully using "WAIT, WATCH and WALK"

RIDING

- obey all the road rules
- wear a helmet
- stop at each intersection
- ride sensibly and carefully
- children under 10 years should not ride to school without the supervision of an adult



CAR

- wear a seat belt
- ask the driver to let you off and pick you up on the school side/home side of the road in a safe place
- look before you cross the road
- parents should walk their children across the road

BUS

- stay seated at all times
- do not distract the bus driver
- take care getting on/off the bus
- follow the safety rules "WAIT, WATCH and WALK"
