What is the Schoolkids Bonus? What is it for?

The Schoolkids Bonus is a payment to help eligible families and students with the education related costs of primary and secondary school studies. The Schoolkids Bonus can be used to assist with the costs of things like school fees, uniforms, books and sports, music or other lessons.

How much will you receive?

Each year, eligible families and students will receive:

- \$410 for each child in primary school (paid in two instalments of \$205)
- \$820 for each child in secondary school (paid in two instalments of \$410).

Who is Eligible?

You could receive the Schoolkids bonus if you have a child in primary or secondary school, or you are a primary or secondary student, and you receive one of the following payments:

Family Tax Benefit Part A, Youth Allowance, Disability Support Pension, ABSTUDY Living Pension, Carer Payment, Parenting Payment, Special Benefit, Education Allowances under the Veterans' Children Education Scheme and Military Rehabilitation and Compensation Act Education and Training Scheme.
