### **Dare to Lead Snapshot**

On Monday 20 and Tuesday 21 May the Dare to lead team will be visiting the school to conduct a collegial school snapshot of our Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Programs. The snapshot involves analysing school data and interviewing students, staff and parents. The purpose of the snapshot is to give the school some possible future directions in the area of Aboriginal education. This is a wonderful opportunity to provide possible direction for the school as we commence the Connected Communities journey. You will have the opportunity to be interviewed and all interviews are completely anonymous. I strongly encourage everyone to find some time to talk to the team and assist this very important process.

### **NAPLN testing**

NAPLAN testing will take place for all Year 3 and Year 5 students next week. The tests will be completed on Tuesday 14, Wednesday 15 and Thursday 16 May. It is very important that your children arrive at school on time ready to complete the tests. This assessment is simply a snapshot of student knowledge and skills on that particular day. Parent reports will be provided during September, 2013 and teachers will be available to discuss the results. If you have any questions about the tests I would encourage you to speak to your child's teacher.

THURSDAY 16TH MAY

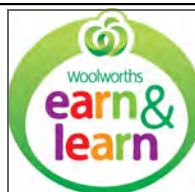
Judy Thomas will visit our kindergarten students and talk to them about the BBC Program (Breath, Blow, Cough).

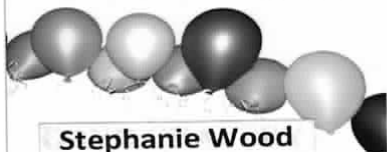

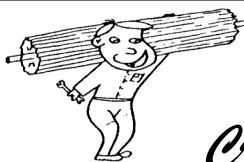

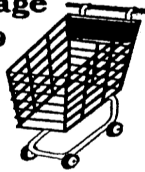
