Active as a Family

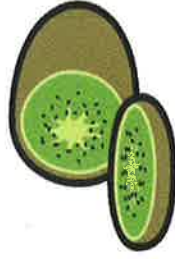
Busy lives and long work schedules can mean that many families spend time apart during the week and exercise on their own.
