Kindergarten in Transition

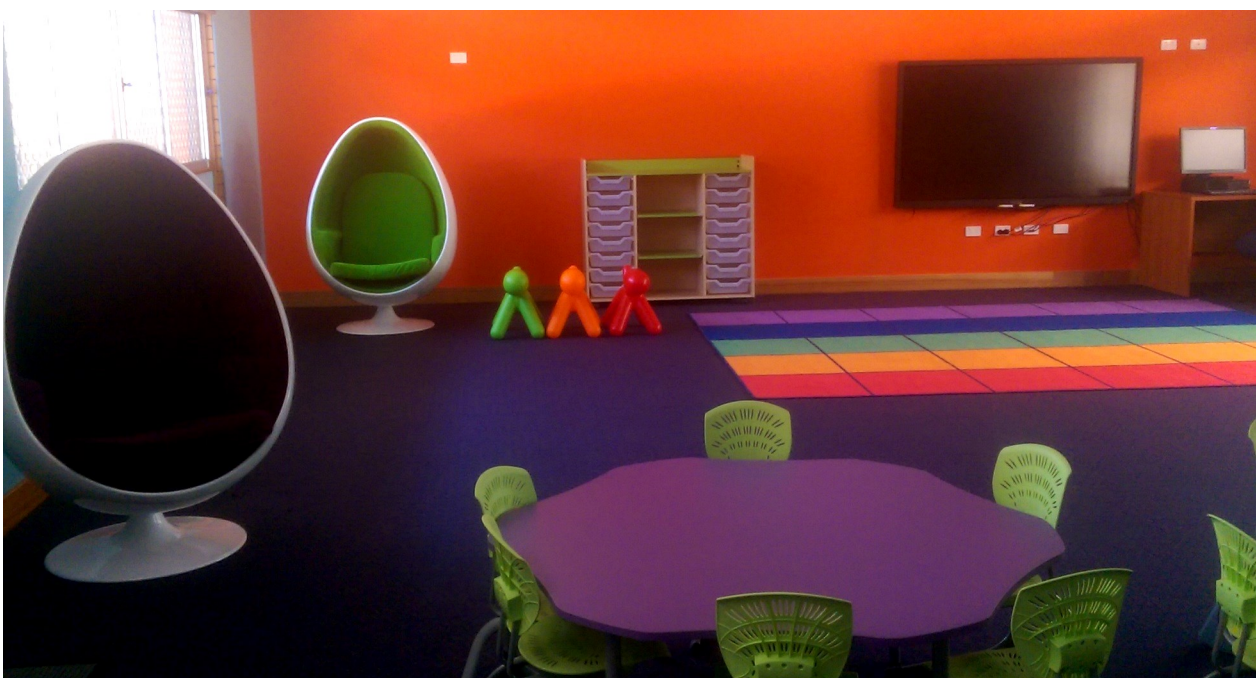

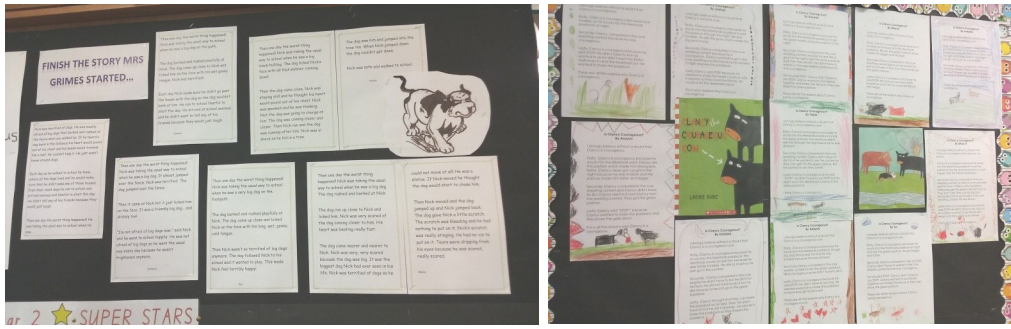
